

In HT1, we explore Industrial Britain, charting the rise of industry in Manchester and around the globe. We also look at the movements born during the period, including the suffragist and suffragette movements.

Half-Term 4: Revolutions We start HT4 by asking whether Cromwell's "revolution" was a success, before undertaking a brief tour of global revolutions Glorious, American, French and Industrial.

Half-Term 3: The Stuarts In HT3, we dive into the Stuarts, exploring how James dealt with gunpowder and witchcraft, why Charles lost his head, and how Cromwell ruled England.

Half-Term 3: Holocaust The greatest crime ever committed; the **Holocaust remains the** greatest tragedy ever experienced. We explore the testimonies of survivors and remember machine.

> **Half-Term 2: Elizabeth** Queen Elizabeth I is one of the most renowned royals of all time. In HT2, we look at how she grew from a disinherited Princess to a powerful warrior Queen.

From the Holocaust to Rwanda, to Darfur, Cambodia, Bosnia, and dozens of other locations, genocide continues to permeate the world. In HT4, we explore past genocides and ask how we those lost to the Nazi war can help prevent genocides.

Half-Term 1: Early Tudors

Moving into Year 8, we look at the early years of one of the most powerful royal dynasties ever to rule - exploring the reigns of Henry VII, Henry VIII, Edward VI, Jane and Mary.



Half-Term 4: Medieval Events In HT4, we flit from the Normans to the bloody murder of Becket, from Becket to the controversial rule of John Lackland, and from John to the Black Death, exploring some of the key events that shaped our country.

Half-Term 5: Medieval World In HT5, we leave Britain to explore other medieval worlds, exploring case studies on **Medieval African Kingdoms and** Medieval Islamic Civilisations. We learn that the world really is interconnected.

Half-Term 6: Local History In HT6, we explore the local area, diving into historic Ramsbottom and exploring the key events through time that have made our community our community.

Half-Term 3: Norman England

In HT3, we learn how the citizens of England adapted to Norman rule, how Knights and Peasants lived, how William fought crime and which jobs were the worst to have.



Half-Term 2: 1066 In HT2 we learn about how William the Conqueror became the first Norman King of England, beating the Viking and Anglo-Saxon contenders in bloody battle.
